BYLAW #330

A BYLAW OF THE VILALGE OF SPRING LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF PLANTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPRING LAKE DESIGNATED AS PROHIBITED NOXIOUS WEEDS AND NOXIOUS WEEDS.

WHEREAS Pursuant to the Province of Alberta Weed Control Act, Statutes of Alberta, 2008 Chapter W-5.1 Current as of June 17, 2010 and all amendments thereto, and the Weed Control Act Weed Control Regulation 19/2010

WHEREAS The Council of the Village of Spring Lake, in the Province of Alberta, deems it expedient to designate plants within the Municipality as prohibited noxious weeds and noxious weeds

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Village of Spring Lake, in the Province of Alberta, IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Village of Spring Lake Weed Control Bylaw.
- 2. a) "Inspector" shall mean a person and/or Bylaw Enforcement Officer appointed as an Inspector on behalf of the Council of the Village of Spring Lake.
 - b) "Local Authority" shall be the Council of the Village of Spring Lake.
- All plants described in Schedule A to this bylaw shall be designated as prohibited noxious weeds or noxious weeds.
- This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of approval by the Minister.
